Job Purpose

To improve the lives of all within our community and help the island thrive by working closely with the Senior Dental Technician & Dentist, on prescription or directly with patients, for the provision or repair of dental prosthetics/devices to enhance patient's oral health, appearance, speech & wellbeing. The trainee will gain practical skills to carry out main duties & responsibilities alongside a structured modular & self-directed learning platform, with progression to a Grade C5, on completion of successfully passing all modular & end of training assessments.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

1. Main Duties of the post will include:

Carry out in-house training, on the Basics of Dental Technology, over a two year period to gain the skills to:

- Design, plan and make a range of custom-made dental devices according to prescription, to include partial and full dentures, removable orthodontic appliances, crowns and bridges
- > Casting of models, Fabrication of special trays, bite blocks, Wax up and Finishing dentures
- Modify dental devices according to prescription
- Carry out infection prevention & control procedures to prevent cross-contamination of work area
- Repair Dentures
- Discuss with dentist/work colleague any problematic dental cases
- 2. To work within standards, procedures, protocols & guidelines of SHG
- 3. To report complaints/accidents in-line with dental clinic polices to Line Manager
- 4. Work as part of a multidisciplinary team to deliver high quality work
- 5. Carry out routine risk assessments, ensure proper handling and control of hazardous materials to ensure safety of staff & service users at all times.



- 6. Keep up to date with new developments in dentistry by completing & maintaining a CPD record.
- 7. Maintain stock levels in accordance with reasonably safe levels to ensure continuity of operational services.
